GLOBAL MIDDAS KAMDHENU GAU VIGYAN KENDRA SAVE COWS BY LAUNCHING COW-BASED PRODUCTS UNDER FARMERS' LIVELIHOOD MISSION IN VILLAGES



CONCEPT NOTE

- 1. It is unfortunate that inspite of the fact that Indians attach so much importance to cow calling it Go-Mata, but when it stops giving milk, the same person abandons the cows to graze in the open. And such stray cows are being caught and smuggled by unscrupulous people only to be butchered in the slaughter houses.
- 2. It is proposed to set up **Global Middas Kamdhenu Gau Vigyan Kendra** in the villages to save such stray cows going into slaughter houses.
- 3. It is proposed to request the District Administration to allocate 10 (Ten) Acres or more land to set up Kamdhenu Gau Vigyan Kendra with shelters for cows and Nandis to protect. The land will further be used to grow high quality fodder grass and also as open grazing ground to allow the cattles to freely move around instead of tied up under the shed in so called Gaushala.
- 4. The Kamdhenu Gau Vigyan Kendra proposes the following action:
- i) Each farmer will be encouraged to adopt atleast one cow by providing shelter to the stray cow at his home. He can bring the cow/cows for grazing in the open field.
- ii) The farmer will be given fodder free to feed the cow, and in return, the farmer will deposit the cow-dung and go-mutra at Kamdhenu Gau Vigyan Kendra.
- iii) The Ten acres of land will be provided with double layer fencing to grow fodder grass
- iv) One large shed will be provided to set up manufacturing of Cow-dung products such as Gau-Kasht (Logs made of Cow-dung), Nursery Pots (Gamla), Diya, and other Cow-products for which the required machines will be procured. The shed will also serve as a temporary shelter for the stray cows till they are adopted by the farmers.
- v) Ladies from the village will be trained in making the Cow-dung products and will be provided remuneration based on daily production.

vi) Two Acres will be allocated for setting up Vermicompost Beds with Multilayer farming for fruits & vegetables which will also serve as shed for the Vermi-compost beds.



vii) Villagers will be trained to manage the Vermi-compost beds and will be provided remuneration on the basis of production.

viii) Between the double layer fencing, Marigold will be grown to launch Bee Keeping under National Honey Mission for which village youth will be trained in Bee Keeping and financial assistance will be given to set up Bee Keeping Unit. KVIC schemes will be implemented in the village.

ix) Based on the number of cows and availability of sufficient quantity of cow-dung, Gobar Gas Plant will be set up to provide Piped Gobar Gas to the farmers at a very nominal rate.
